Prime Minister's meeting with Federal Minister Sci & Tech, PNAC and PSQCA

Federal Minister of Science & Tech Ch. Fawad Hussain along with Federal Secretary (Ministry of Science & Technology), DG PNAC, and DG PSQCA attended a meeting with Prime Minister of Pakistan Mr. Imran Khan on 10th September 2020. Ms. Ismat briefed the Prime Minister on the importance of accreditation, related processes and requirements. Prime Minister expressed keen interest in the accreditation process and inquired further on how PNAC acquires the authority to accredit. It was explained that this is done through peer evaluation.



Public private partnership of conformity assessment accreditation of PSQCA regulated products was also discussed. Industrial and business sectors which will be brought under this partnership were reviewed.

Global and Regional Importance of PNAC

As international trade has grown so too has the number of national and international voluntary and mandatory technical regulations, standards, testing, inspection and certification procedures. This is seen as a trend across all market sectors which apply to samples, products, services, management systems or personnel. PNAC helps meet the regulatory requirements of quality and safety that consumers, businesses, regulators and other organizations demand in the case of goods and services irrespective of the country of origin. PNAC accreditation services help with export of products and services across borders to meet global demand without causing undue risk to the health and security of individuals or the environment. Hence, the role that PNAC plays is not only important for individuals and organizations but for national and international economic health.

ADB country representatives discussed key development issues in accordance with PNAC policy and future action plan with the Director General (PNAC) on 11th August 2020.





Five days course allows participants to develop practical understanding of the assessment methodology used by a Pakistan National Accreditation Council through lectures, exercises, role play and 3 hrs exam at the end. Interactive sessions during training enables professionals to build capability to initiate and spearhead the Implementation of ISO 15189 in medical laboratories.
